Our committee is very active.

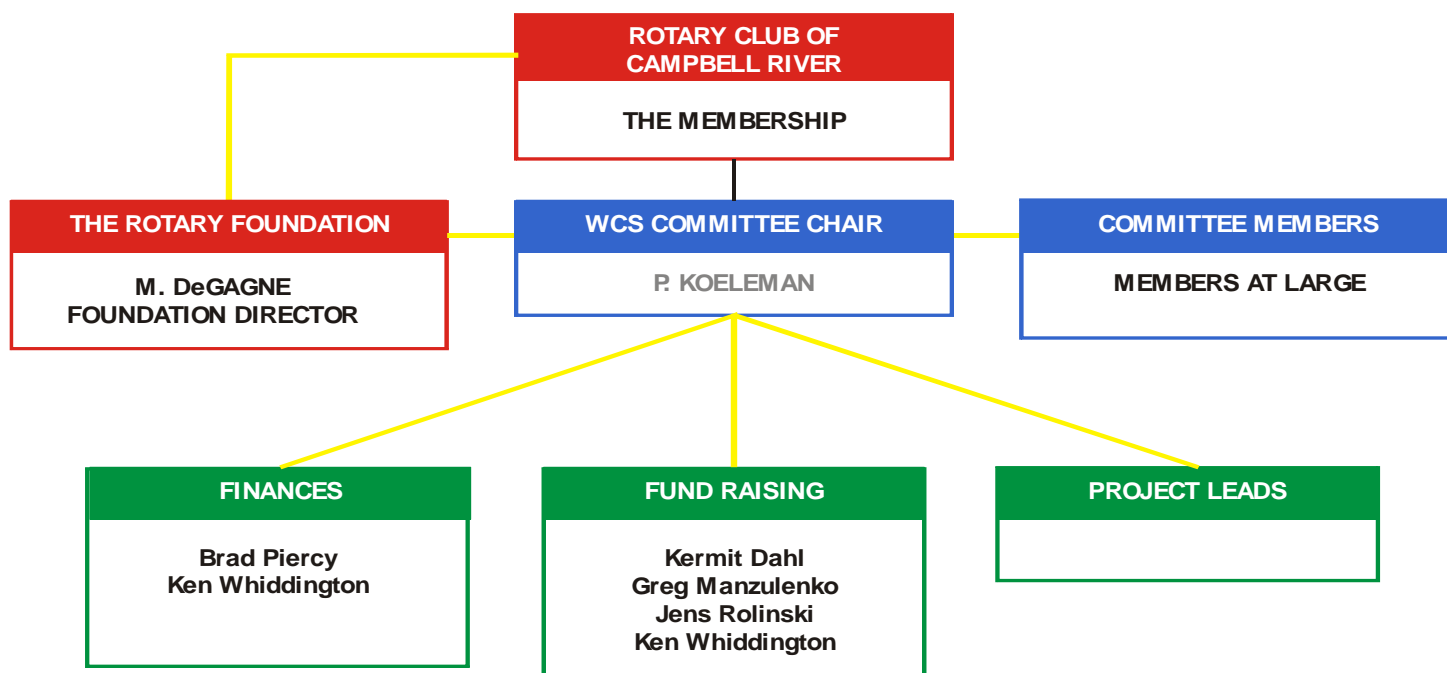
You can get involved anytime, just ask when our next meeting is.
